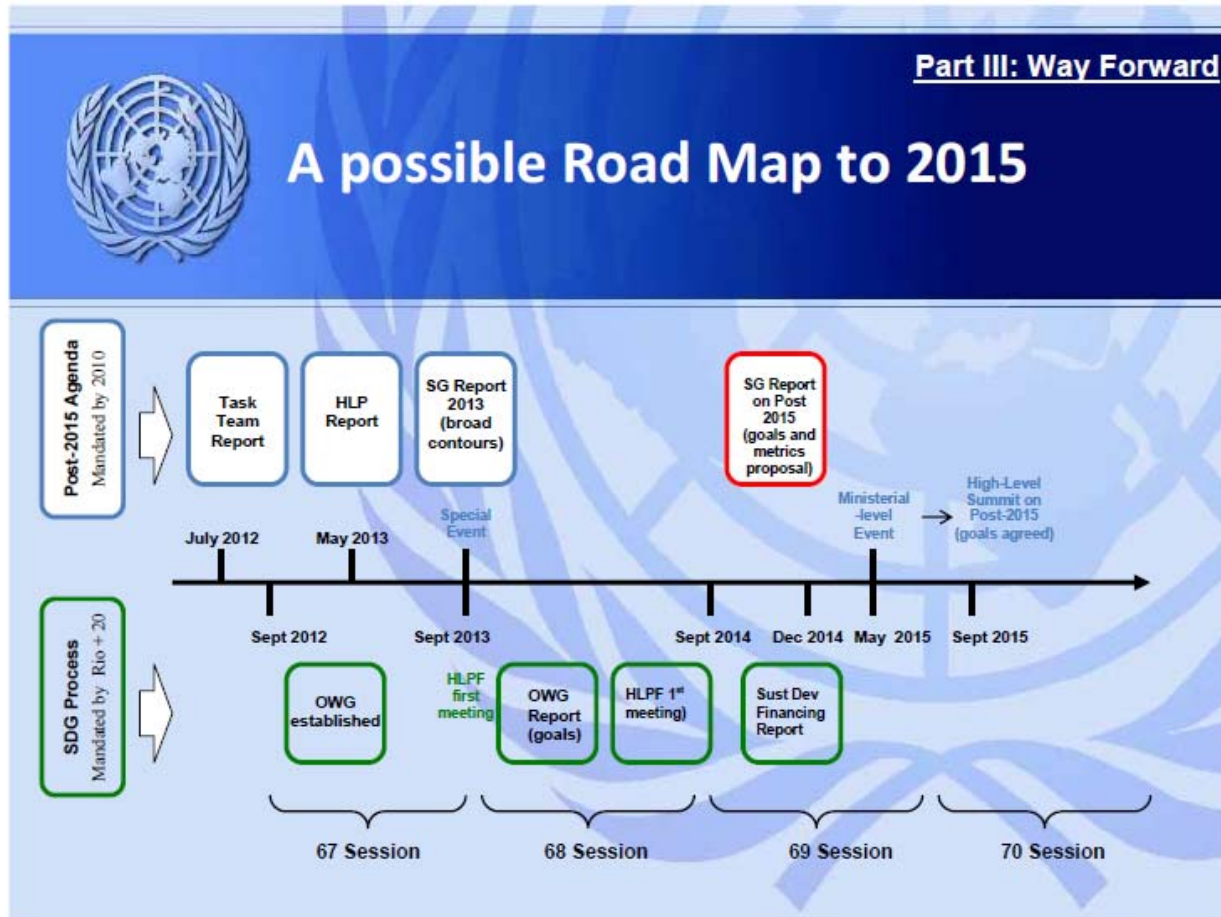
Strong report from the SG combined with effective political leadership from the Special Event and the Forum could provide decisive momentum for the process

## Special Event 25 September: Outcome Document

- We gather with a sense of urgency and determination, with less than 850 days remaining for the achievements of MDGs.
- We also recognise the special challenges and needs of SIDS and the LLDC, We also recognise the specific challenges which many middle-income countries face.
- We emphasise the need to accelerate progress towards the target of 0.7% of GNI as ODA by 2015, including 0.25% to 0.20% for least developed countries.
- Recognising the intrinsic inter linkage between poverty eradication and promotion of sustainable development.
- This coherent approach involves world towards a single framework and set of Goals -universal in nature and applicable to all countries, while taking account of differing national circumstances .
- . It should also promote peace and security, democratic governance, the rule of law, gender equality and human rights for all.

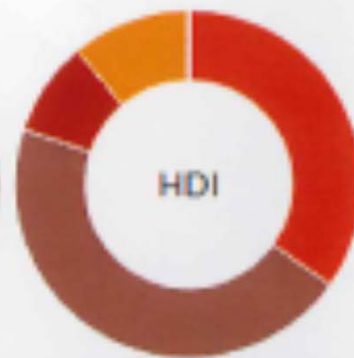
